

New York State Crime Report

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Crime in New York State 2022 Final Data

New York State and the FBI use seven Index crime categories as indicators of overall crime trends: murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault, which are classified as violent crimes, and the property crimes of burglary, larceny and motor vehicle theft. The FBI created these categories to allow for uniform crime reporting across all 50 states. Police departments and sheriffs' offices in New York report Index crime to the Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) through the Uniform Crime Reporting and Incident-Based Reporting programs. This report details 2022 Index crime in New York State, its 62 counties and two regions: New York City and the 57 counties outside of the five boroughs (Non-New York City). This report also details Index crime rates per 100,000 population statewide and by county and region. DCJS uses county population data from the FBI, which is based on U.S. Census estimates, to calculate crime rates.

New York State implemented the FBI's expanded definition of rape in 2015; this resulted in an uptick in violent crime and reported rapes in that year compared to prior years. As a result, caution should be used when citing or interpreting any percentage changes between rapes reported in 2015, and any subsequent year, to those reported in 2014 and earlier.

The FBI made the change to more accurately reflect the scope and volume of sexual assaults nationwide. Before the implementation, those offenses would have been classified by the FBI and state as Part II sex offenses.


This report compares Index and violent crime over the 10-year period from 2013 through 2022, but it <u>does not</u> include percentage change comparisons between rape statistics reported in 2013 vs. 2022 because of the expanded definition.

Index crime in New York State increased (+22%) in 2022 compared to 2021, with 421,322 Index crimes reported. The increase was driven by a 25 percent increase in all three property crimes and increases in the violent crimes of robbery (+25%) and aggravated assault (+9%). Murder (-11%) and rape (-4%) both decreased.

The state's Index crime rate declined by 3 percent when comparing 2013 and 2022. During the same time period, the violent crime rate increased 11 percent and New York State experienced a 36 percent increase in firearm-related homicides when comparing 2013 to 2022 (See page 4 for additional details). This significant increase mirrored trends that occurred nationally.


Percentage Change in Crime Rates 2021 vs. 2022




Change in Crime Volume: 2013 vs. 2022

Index crime decreased steadily for six consecutive years beginning in 2013 and reached historic lows in 2019. Crime levels remained stable through 2020 and 2021 before increasing sharply in 2022 by 22 percent.


Despite the sharp increase in reported crime from 2021 to 2022, there were 11,384 fewer crimes reported statewide (-3%) when compared to 2013.

Regional Trends in Violent Crime



Comparing Index crimes in 2022 to 2013 in the state's two regions, reported crime in Non-New York City decreased by 54,683 crimes while New York City increased by 43,299 crimes reported. This represents a 23 percent decrease in Non-New York City and a 22 percent increase in New York City.

In 2022, total crime volume in Non-New York City was lower than New York City for the fourth year in a row.

While reported violent crime decreased 3 percent in Non-New York City (2022 vs 2013), New York City reported a 17 percent increase in violent crime.

As noted, the state's implementation of the FBI's expanded definition of rape resulted in an increase in violent crime in both regions from 2014 to 2015. This change resulted in 3,486 additional crimes being classified as rape in 2022; prior to the change, those offenses would have been classified by the FBI and state as Part II sex offenses.


Statewide Crime Trends: 2021 vs. 2022

The number of Index crimes reported in New York State increased by 22 percent in 2022 compared to the previous year.

Total violent crime increased by 11 percent with increases in the violent crime categories of robbery (+22%), and aggravated assault (+9%). Murder (-11%) and rape (-4%) decreased.

Property crime increased by 25 percent, driven by increases in burglary (+17%), larceny (+26%), and motor vehicle theft (+22%). Larcenies comprise nearly 83 percent of all property crimes reported.


Percentage Change in Crime Volume 2021 vs. 2022

Non-New York City



New York City

Index crimes increased 27 percent in 2022 compared to 2021, with increases in both violent crime (+15%) and property crime (+32%).

Three of the four violent crimes saw increases: rape (+6%), robbery (+25%), and aggravated assault (+12%). Murder was the only violent crime to decrease (-10%).

All three property crimes increased during the same period: burglary (+26%), larceny (+33%), and motor vehicle theft (+31%).

Non-New York City

Index crimes increased 16 percent in 2022 compared to 2021, largely due to an 18 percent increase in property crime.

Violent crime increased about 1 percent, with decreases in murder (-11%) and rape (-11%), and increases in robbery (+9%) and aggravated assault (+3%).


Property crime increased 18 percent, with increases reported in all three crimes: burglary (+10%), larceny (+20%), and motor vehicle theft (+13%).

Trends in Violent Crime by Firearm: 2018 vs. 2022

In New York City, the number of violent crimes involving firearms more than doubled when comparing 2018 to 2022 (4,245 vs. 9,062). There was a 15 percent increase in 2022 when compared to 2021, when 7,870 crimes by firearm were reported.

Violent crimes involving a firearm outside of New York City increased 32 percent in 2022 as compared to 2018 (4,841vs. 3,663). In 2022, there were 66 fewer violent crimes by firearm (4,841 vs. 4,907) compared to 2021.



Regional Trends in Homicide: 2013 through 2022

In 2022, total homicides and firearm-related homicides in New York State decreased after increasing sharply in 2020 and 2021. Statewide, there were 791 homicides, an 11 percent decrease compared to 2021. That year, there were 885 homicides reported, the most since 2006. Homicides and other index crimes reported annually from 2000 through 2023 are available online.

Reported homicide for New York City decreased 10 percent (438 vs. 488) and declined 11 percent (353 vs. 397) in Non-New York City.

When comparing 2022 to 2013, homicides statewide increased 23 percent (791 vs. 645). Regionally, homicides increased 31 percent (438 vs. 335) in New York City and 14 percent (353 vs. 310) in Non-New York City when comparing 2022 to 2013.

The increase in violent crime and rape between 2014 and 2015 is attributable to New York State's implementation of the FBI's <u>expanded definition</u> of rape.
